## **Privacy Policy**

As a nonprofit organization, the Southport Oak Island Interchurch Fellowship (SOIICF) places a high priority on protecting your privacy. This privacy policy was created in order to demonstrate SOIICF's commitment to the privacy of our Volunteers, Donors and other website visitors. This policy explains what types of information is collected by SOIICF's website, [www.soiicf.org](http://www.soiicf.org), and how this information is used.

### **What Personally Identifiable Information is Collected**

SOIICF's and other website visitors that register to use [www.soiicf.org](http://www.soiicf.org) voluntarily provide us with contact information (such as name, address, telephone, church and e-mail address). We use this information internally for providing personalized service and for monitoring website traffic. We will not share, sell or rent this information to anyone.

### **Internet Protocol (IP) addresses**

SOIICF may use your Internet Protocol (IP) address for statistical metrics used to track website visitor traffic.

### **Cookies**

Cookies are small bits of code that are sent to your computer when you logon to a website that allows us to identify you when you return to the site. SOIICF uses "cookie" messages to automatically help provide better services. They remind us who you are and your preferences for our website based on what you've done and told us before. The "cookie" is placed on your computer and is read when you come back to our website. Cookies let us take you to the information and features you're particularly interested in. They also let us track your usage of [www.soiicf.org](http://www.soiicf.org), so we know which parts of our sites are most popular. You can reject cookies or cancel them by instructing your web browser accordingly.

### **How Your Information May Be Used**

We use your personal information to provide you with personalized service; to send e-mail alerts to you; to answer your requests; to process your volunteer application; etc. You may choose to opt out at any time, which will cease communications from us. You may do so [here](#). We may also use your information to track your visits to our website. This lets us see which of our features are the most popular so we can better serve our users' needs.

## **Security**

The security of your Personal Information is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

## **Electronic Messages**

We send electronic messages, updates, schedule information, etc and Public Policy Updates on a regular basis to our Volunteers. The electronic messages are sent to your preferred email address. You may choose to opt out at any time, which will cease communications from us. You may do so [here](#) or by clicking the link provided in every electronic communication.

## **Modifications**

We may amend this privacy policy from time to time; please review it periodically. We maintain the option to modify this policy at any time by electronic notice posted on our website.
